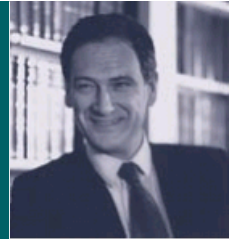

Re a Debtor (No 1 of 1987) [1989] 2 All ER 46 (a decision of the Court of Appeal on the validity of a statutory demand).

Buckinghamshire County Council v Moran [1989] 2 All ER 225 (a decision of the Court of Appeal on acquiring title to land by limitation).

Re Berkeley Applegate Ltd [1989] BCLC 28 (a case concerning a liquidator's right to be remunerated out of assets held on trust by the company in liquidation).

Barlow Clowes Gilt Management Ltd v Clowes The Times, 2 February 1990 (one of the many cases in the Barlow Clowes litigation in which Peter Griffiths acted for the liquidators and receivers).

SIB v Scandex Capital Management A/S [1998] 1 WLR 712, [1998] 1 All ER 514 (a decision of the Court of Appeal on the Financial Services Act 1986).

Re Park Air Services Plc [1999] 2 WLR 396, [1999] 1 All ER 673 (a decision of the House of Lords on damages on disclaimer).

Re Cadogan Estates Ltd v McMahon [2000] 3 WLR 1555 (a decision of the House of Lords on the Rent Act 1977).

Doreen Tibbs v Mayor and Burgesses of Islington London Borough Council [2002] EWCA Civ 1682, [2003] BPIR 743 (a claim for malicious prosecution).

Re Anglo German Breweries Ltd [2003] BTC 5021 (a winding up petition based on assessments for VAT and excise duty subject to appeals).

Colonial Finance (UK) Ltd v KSC Trading Ltd [2003] EWCA Civ 1593 (a case involving detailed accounting in relation to hire purchase agreements).

Hunter v Senate Support Services Ltd & Ors [2005] 1 BCLC 175 (an action to set aside the forfeiture of shares for non payment of calls).

Hocking & Anor v Canyon Holdings Ltd [2004] EWHC (Ch) 1966 (a claim by a trustee in bankruptcy to set aside a transaction at an undervalue).

Shahar v Tsitsekkos & Ors [2004] EWHC (Ch) 7659 (a case concerning service out of the jurisdiction under the Judgments Regulation and CPR r.6.20).

Lennox Lewis v Panos Eliades & Ors [2005] EWHC (Ch) 488 (a claim by a judgment creditor with the benefit of a charging order that the property charged belonged to the judgment debtor rather than the registered proprietor).

BNP Paribas UK v Yukos Oil Co. [2005] EWHC 1321 (resisting application for summary judgment in a claim under a loan agreement).

VFS Financial Services (UK) Ltd v Euro Auctions (UK) Ltd [2007] EWHC 1492 (QB) (defending claim for conversion).

Southern Counties Fresh Foods Ltd [2008] EWHC 2810 (unfair prejudice petition).

Sunrise Radio Ltd [2009] EWHC 2893 (Ch) (unfair prejudice petition).
